Accessing the FalconNet Wireless System in Windows 8.1 & 10

The following steps explain how to connect for the first time. After the initial connection is established, you will connect automatically when you are in range of the network.


The screenshots below are for Windows 10. Windows 8.1 is very similar, but the screens may differ slightly.


1. Click the wireless icon on the system tray (lower right portion of the screen next to the date and time).



2. Click the **FalconNet** network connection.



3. Click the check box next to *Connect Automatically*. Then click **Connect**.



4. If prompted, enter your FalconNet username and password and then click **OK**.
